

NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE

North Zulch ISD does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, or disability in providing education services, activities, and programs, including vocational programs, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

The North Zulch Independent School District does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, disability or age in its programs and activities. North Zulch ISD provides a free, appropriate education consisting of regular or special education and related aids and services in CATE programs that are designed to meet individual educational needs of disabled persons as adequately as the needs of non-disabled persons.

RECORDS

The North Zulch ISD maintains general education records required by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974.

The district makes available to parents information concerning their child enrolled in school unless the district is notified that the parent does not have that authority under state law. When the student reaches 18 years of age and is no longer dependent, all rights of the parents are transferred to the student.

Parents, the student and officials of the district with legitimate educational interests are the only persons with general access to the records. The district also forwards education records on request to a school in which a student seeks or intends to enroll without the parent's permission.

Certain other officials from various governmental agencies may have limited access to the records. The principal is custodian of all records for currently enrolled students at the assigned school. A record of disclosure of personally identifiable information is maintained and available for the parent's inspection. Some items of information are directory information: a student's name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, awards received in school, most recent previous school attended, and other similar information.

Objections to release of any or all directory information should be directed to the principal.

If a parent believes that the student records should be corrected, the parent may request amendment of the records. Copies of records are available at cost, payable in advance.
